# **Functionality**

### Homepage Navigation

All visitors can find buttons in the navigation bar displayed on the homepage. The navigation bar consists of the logo of the website, search collection, and the login button. After, if the visitor decides to log in and use the website as a member, there will be a profile button to check the user's profile and a logout button.

#### Showcase

Below the title page, there's a showcase section that is displayed with a carousel. They have containers showing an image and the artwork's explanation such as the artist's name, description, and year of installation. It is available for both members and non-members, but the members can see their favorite art type displayed in the carousel. For all visitors, there is an "explore" button below the showcase, allowing visitors to go to the details page where they can check the entire artwork information.

#### <u>About</u>

Below the showcase section, there is an about page which is a description of the purpose of the site. Also, below the about section, this page contains a brief description from the website creators, Sooa and Gabriela.

#### Search Collections

There will be a search system that allows you to search for all works of art. We will utilize the database when users decide to search for an item. Filters use drop boxes to specify words. The filters we included are two: the art's type and the neighbourhood they are located in.

In addition, these search designations are available not only to members who have logged in but also to all visitors. Visitors can view detailed artwork information when they click on the art's details below the image.

## Detail page

On the detail page, the picture of the artwork is shown first. Below is displayed the artwork's description followed by the art's year of installation, artist project statement, type, status, site name, material, ownership, neighbourhood, location on site, external URL that shows more pictures of the artwork an a google maps of its location, and the artist name and last name.

Our subgoal of putting the google maps location was not included since the external URL provides that to the user already. Also, below the art's entire description, there is a favorite list button which is only available for members to add to their favourite list.

## Profile page

It is a page only members can have and view. In this page the logged in username is displayed with a welcome message. Below their name and last name is displayed as well as their email and favorite art type. In addition, there is an option where the user can select their preferred image as well as a button where the users can edit their profile image, edit their profile information, and see their favorite selected art.

For the edit profile image page, the user is provided with an option to upload an image file and submit when they are ready. Furthermore, the edit profile page provides the user with an option to change their name, last name, username, email, password, and their favorite art type. Also, before submitting, the user is required to fill in all of the fields.

## • Favourite list page

This is a list of artworks that will be shown once the member presses the "add to favorite list" button. Additionally, the artwork can be deleted from the favorite's list using the "remove" button.
